

MEDICOS Newsletter Terms of Service

Terms of e-mail commercial information distribution service.

1. The owner of the medicos.com.pl website (hereinafter referred to as the Website) and the Personal Data Controller of the “MEDICOS Newsletter” is MEDICOS Edyta Hryniecka with its registered office: Ukryty Raj 4 lok. 1, Warsaw 02-757, NIP: 7381806412 (hereinafter referred to as MEDICOS or the Controller).
2. The rules of processing personal data are described in the Privacy and Cookies Policy, available in the Service tab at <https://medicos.com.pl/polityka-prywatnosci/>.

4. The object of the “MEDICOS Newsletter” service is to send via e-mail commercial information to the Subscriber’s e-mail address, on a periodic basis, as an e-mail, hereinafter referred to as Newsletter.
5. The newsletter subscription form requires you to enter your name and e-mail address in the corresponding box. These fields are mandatory. Then, in order to have their e-mail address added to the Controller’s subscriber database, the User must confirm their desire to subscribe. The data thus obtained are added to the newsletter mailing list.
6. By subscribing/signing up, the User agrees with the Privacy and Cookies Policy and agrees to be sent marketing and commercial information by means of electronic communication, e.g. e-mail, within the meaning of the Act of July 18, 2002 on the provision of electronic services (Journal of Laws No. 144, item 1204, as amended).
7. By signing up for the newsletter, the User also agrees to the Controller’s use of the User’s telecommunications terminal devices (e.g. phone, tablet, computer) for the purpose of direct marketing of the Controller’s products and services and presentation of commercial information to the User in accordance with Article 172(1) of the Telecommunications Law (Journal of Laws 2014, item 243, as amended).
8. Only personal data provided voluntarily by the Subscriber for the purpose necessary to carry out the provisions of these Terms of Service and the services provided hereunder, and for promotional and marketing purposes, shall be collected. The Subscriber has the right to access the content of the Subscriber’s personal data and the right to rectify and erase them.
9. The Newsletter subscription service is free of charge and available to any Subscriber who has subscribed to the service and activated it by confirming the subscription in the activation link they receive at the e-mail address provided in the form.
10. The Newsletter includes but is not limited to a description of the current commercial offering, information on promotions, discounts and events organized by the Controller and its partners.
11. Activation of the Newsletter mailing service by the Subscriber takes place by:
 - a) entering the e-mail address to which the Subscriber wishes to receive the Newsletter in the corresponding subscription box and agreeing to the processing of the Subscriber’s personal data for marketing purposes;
 - b) and activating the link provided in the e-mail sent automatically to the address provided by the Subscriber, in order to verify the correctness of the information provided at sign-up.

12. Failure to confirm the correct verification of the Subscriber's e-mail address, will result in the removal of the data entered into the database after 30 days from the date of subscription.
13. Each Newsletter Subscriber may opt out of getting the Newsletter by:
 - a) clicking on the opt-out link found in the footer of each e-mail; or
 - b) sending an e-mail to the Controller's address with a request to remove the Subscriber's data from the Newsletter database.

After performing one of the above actions, the Subscriber is cancelled from the Newsletter subscription list. After the withdrawal of consent, the User's data may still be stored in the newsletter database for up to 1 year, in order to demonstrate the fact that the User has agreed to receive communication via the newsletter, the User's actions (email openability), and the moment of withdrawal, as well as possible related claims, which constitutes the Controller's legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR).

14. The mailing system used to send the Newsletter records all activity and actions taken by the User related to the e-mails sent to them (date and time of e-mail opening, clicks on links, timing of unsubscribing, etc.).
15. The e-mail address provided by the Subscriber for the purposes of using the Newsletter will not be transferred to third parties without the Subscriber's consent.
16. Complaints about the service should be addressed via email to the Controller's email address. A complaint should describe the problem in detail. Replies to complaints will be provided within 14 days from the date of receipt of the complaint, by e-mail to the address from which the complaint was received.
17. The Controller has the right to remove any invalid and non-existent e-mail address of the Subscriber from the list of Subscribers without giving any reason.
18. The Controller reserves the right to discontinue the Newsletter mailing service for all or individual Subscribers without giving any reason, upon notifying the Subscribers (Subscriber) of this fact via e-mail.
